## Working group (1): TI

### Summary of the objectives:

- Research on methods to improve TI estimation by different lidar types compared to cup anemometer TI by a follow-up to the IEA Task 32 Round Robin
- Bring together the different perspectives on TI from different parties like measurement institutes, turbine manufacturers and research institutes
- Develop new ideas on how to tackle the task of satisfactory and standardised TI estimation through lidar technology
- Update the “Estimating Turbulence Statistics and Parameters from Ground- and Nacelle-Based Lidar Measurements: IEA Wind Expert Report”, issued by D. Schlipf et al. in 2015

Additional objectives might be added in the future.
